Our return date to Estonia is Oct 5th. Due to COVID our return in June was put off. It will be bittersweet!!

The week after our return, Oct 12-23, will be our first Bible college course - dispensational and covenant theology (BTW I got my Masters of Biblical Studies this year). These Bible classes are a dream come true for us. Be in prayer for this that many will come and be blessed. So many of the church leaders are weak on theology. We are excited to see the Christians form proper theology and doctrine by correctly interpreting the Bible.

Another prayer request: We have our eye on a small building that we can use to start church services as well as accommodate the teen and kid clubs that have outgrown our room we rent. Please pray we can raise the extra funds to rent or even better buy the building. It would also be big enough to start a christian library as well that would benefit Christians and the Bible college.

Another ministry we would like to start is a baseball club to meet new families. Most there have never played and our teens are excited to learn. It is a great way for them to invite their friends that have parents who would never let them come to a church and introduce them to the gospel. Prayers please.
